Guidelines for Full Paper Preparation

All presented papers will be printed as Workshop Proceedings and distributed to all participants. These notes are to help authors prepare full paper for publication in Workshop Proceedings.

Length of the Paper

The maximum length of the paper should not exceed 20 pages (A4 Paper Size, single space-12 font size)

Paper Template for Full Paper (.doc)

Full paper should be submitted as **Microsoft Word file (.doc)**. The format is provided, as being attached on the next page, for author to insert text and graphic without any change. Text should be typed **single-spaced** on A4 size paper only. Please use a Times New Roman- 12 pt justified typeface.

Details are as follows:

Title and Author of the Paper

Each paper must include a title at the top of the first page. Name(s) of author(s) should be included directly under the title, together with full postal and e-mail addresses for each author.

Abstract

An abstract should be included and should not be of more than 200-500 words in length.

Keywords

3-6 keywords (in alphabetical order) which will enable a subsequent information retrieval system to locate the paper

Main Text

For clarity, this should be subdivided into: Introduction, Methods & Materials, Results, Discussion and Conclusions. However, it is allowed for authors to change the titles of these subdivisions in order to reflect more clearly the meaning of the text.

Author's Bibliography

A short bibliography for the first author should be included at the end of the paper. The bibliography should include a brief academic background, current research area(s) and contact information of the author(s).

References

These should be to accessible sources. Please ensure that all work cited in the text is included in the reference list, and that the dates and authors given in the text match those in the reference list. References must always be given in sufficient detail for the reader to locate the work cited (see below for format)

Tables and Figures

Figures and tables should appear in numerical order, be described in the body of the text and be positioned close to where they are first cited. (format of caption: Table 1, Fig. 1....). Make sure all figures and tables will fit inside the text area. Original line drawings are acceptable but glossy prints are preferred (for quality of reproduction). Avoid using shading in figures. Photographs should be in black and white, and should be sharp and well contrasted.

The Deadline of Full Paper Submission: September 1, 2017

Oral Presentation

Each presenter has 20 minute including discussion for 5 minute.

PC computers (with Microsoft Office 2007/2008) assisted LCD projector are available.

Presenters are requested to bring their presentation on USB memory stick.

Poster

The poster size is recommended A1 (59.4cm x84.1cm). Kindly note to the authors, please print and bring the posters to the workshop, the supporting board will be provided by LOC.

ABSTRACT

Abstract no more than 500 words briefly specifying the aims of the work, the main results obtained, and the conclusion drawn.

KEYWORDS

Provide 3-6 keywords (in alphabetical order) which will enable a subsequent information retrieval system to locate the paper.

INTRODUCTION (optional – Author may change titles of the main text freely according to the contents of the section —for example: *BACKGROUND*, or *HISTORICAL BACKGROUND*)

Describing the background of the work and its aims.

Text should be typed single-spaced on this format only. Do not exceed the dimensions given in this format. Please use a Times New Roman 12 pt. Insert one return between paragraphs. The main body text should be typed justified with no indents.

MATERIALS AND METHODS (optional)

A brief description of the methods/techniques used

Text should be typed single-spaced on this format only. Do not exceed the dimensions given in this format. Please use a Times New Roman 12 pt. Insert one return between paragraphs. The main body text should be typed justified with no indents.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (optional)

A clear presentation of experimental results obtained, highlighting any trends or points of interest.

Text should be typed single-spaced on this format only. Do not exceed the dimensions given in this format. Please use a Times New Roman 12 pt. Insert one return between paragraphs. The main body text should be typed justified with no indents.

CONCLUSIONS

A brief explanation of the significance and implications of the work reported.
